- 1. <u>Charles A. Decker</u> was appointed to Seat No.
  1 of the Manatee County Code Enforcement Board on September 24, 1992 to fill an unexpired term, and this term shall expire on October 14, 1994.
- Jerry L. Brwin was appointed to Seat No.
   of the Manatee County Code Enforcement Board on September 24, 1992, and this term shall expire on October 14, 1994.
- 3. <u>J. Michael Faarup</u> was appointed to Seat No. 3 of the Manatee County Code Enforcement Board on September 24, 1992, and this term shall expire on October 14, 1995.
- Robert B. Whitehead is hereby appointed to Seat No. 4 of the Manatee County Code Enforcement Board, and this term shall expire on October 14, 1995.
- Robert L. French is hereby appointed to Seat No. 3 of the Manatee County Code Enforcement Board, and this term shall expire on October 14, 1995.
- This resolution shall become effective immediately upon execution of this document.

RESOLUTION OF THE MANATEE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS APPOINTING THREE MEMBERS TO THE CODE ENFORCEMENT BOARD (CEB).

- 3. <u>J. Michael Faarup</u> is hereby appointed to Seat No. 3 of the Manatee County Code Enforcement Board, and this term shall expire on October 14, 1995.
- This resolution shall become effective immediately upon execution of this document.
