A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING USE OF LAW ENFORCEMENT IMPACT FEES TO REIMBURSE THE MANATEE COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE FOR FUNDS ADVANCED TO ACQUIRE CAPITAL ITEMS ELIGIBLE FOR FUNDING FROM LAW ENFORCEMENT IMPACT FEES

WHEREAS, Manatee County Florida has adopted a Land Development Code which includes impact fee provisions pursuant to Article VIII of the Florida Constitution and Chapters 125 and 163 of the Florida Statutes and,

WHEREAS, Section 803 of the Land Development Code authorizes imposition of certain impact fees on new development, proceeds from which must be used for Law Enforcement and,

WHEREAS, section 805.7.4. of the Land Development Code allows for reimbursement from Law Enforcement Impact Fees when funds for eligible expenses are initially borrowed from non-impact fee sources if approved by resolution finding that the capital improvement for which the funds are borrowed shall mitigate capital needs created by impact-generating land development activity.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has agreed to reimburse Manatee County Sheriff's Department for the purchase of a helicopter and equipment which meets the impact fee use requirements of Section 804 of the Land Development Code.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS of Manatee County, Florida:

1. Acquisition of a helicopter and related equipment for the Sheriff's law enforcement activities will mitigate capital needs created by impact - generating land development activity.
2. By adoption of this resolution, reimbursement is authorized from the Law Enforcement Impact Fee Fund to the Manatee County Sheriff's Department to repay funds advanced for the purchase of a helicopter and related equipment.
3. Such reimbursement shall not exceed \$312,655.
