

RESOLUTION R-94-292

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR FOR
PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT TO DISBURSE NOT MORE THAN
THREE THOUSAND (1,000 ADULT, 1,000 STUDENT, AND
1,000 SENIOR) BUS TICKETS PER YEAR TO BE USED IN
PROMOTING THE COUNTY BUS SYSTEM TO THE RESIDENTS
OF MANATEE COUNTY; AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION R-92-242**

WHEREAS, Ordinance 74-6 authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to establish a public transportation system within the territorial boundaries of Manatee County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners believes that wider utilization of public transportation through greater promotion will assist in alleviating traffic congestion and enhancing the County's economic growth; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desires to promote wider utilization of the County Transit System while maintaining a minimum of operating cost; and

WHEREAS, the Transit Section has been recently reorganized and moved from the Community Services Department and placed under the Public Transportation Department; and

WHEREAS, Resolution R-92-242 previously granted authority to the Community Services Director to disburse complimentary bus tickets intended to promote the use of the public transportation system in Manatee County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, that:

1. Resolution R-92-242 is rescinded in its entirety.
2. The Director of the Public Transportation Department is hereby authorized to disburse not more than three thousand (1,000 adult, 1,000 student, and 1,000 senior) bus tickets per year to be used in promoting the County bus system to the residents of Manatee County.

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR FOR
PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT
FOR SALE OF MANATEE COUNTY AREA TRANSIT SYSTEM BUS
TICKETS BY RETAIL ESTABLISHMENTS**

WHEREAS, Ordinance 74-6 authorizes the Board of County commissioners to establish a public transportation system within the territorial boundaries of Manatee County; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Manatee County Public Transportation Department is responsible for and in charge of the day-to-day operations of the Transit Section, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners deems it is in the public interest to enhance the economic development of the County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desires to promote wider utilization of the Manatee County Area Transit System while maintaining a minimum of personnel costs; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners believes that wider utilization of public transportation through the promotion of greater accessibility of such public transportation which relieves public congestion and provides full efficient transportation will enhance County economic growth;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, as follows:

The Director of the Manatee County Public Transportation Department is authorized to enter into agreements with such retail establishments as said Director shall deem responsible, which agreements shall provide for the distribution to and the sale by each such retail establishment of Manatee County Area Transit System Bus Tickets, and be substantially in accordance with the form of agreement attached as Exhibit "A".

BUS TICKET SALES AGREEMENT

AGREEMENT made this ___ day of _____, 199__, by and between BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, (herein sometimes called "COUNTY") and _____ having a place of business located at _____ (herein the "RETAILER").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desires to enhance the economic development of Manatee County by among other things, the wider utilization of the County Transit System; and

WHEREAS, wider utilization of the County Transit system will enable a greater number of people to shop and patronize the retail establishments in Manatee County, including the RETAILER; and

WHEREAS, the availability of County Transit System Bus Tickets will bring customers to RETAILER's establishments.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree upon the following terms and conditions:

1. The COUNTY shall distribute to the RETAILER and the RETAILER will offer for sale for and on behalf of the COUNTY, County Transit Bus Tickets.
2. RETAILER hereby acknowledges receipt of _____ Adult Tickets, _____ Student Tickets, and _____ Golden Age Passes.
3. Until the price of said Bus Tickets shall be changed by the COUNTY, the RETAILER shall sell said Bus Tickets at the following prices:

STUDENT PASS

Easy Rider	10 Ride Punch Pass; \$6.00
Super Rider	40 Ride Punch Pass; \$20.00
Strip of Tickets	10 Ride Strip of Tickets; \$6.00
Discount Pass	Unlimited Rides Senior/Student/Handicapped; \$14.00

ADULT PASS

Easy Rider	10 Ride Punch Pass; \$8.50
Super Rider	40 Ride Punch Pass; \$30.00
Strip of Tickets	10 Ride Strip of Tickets; \$8.50
Adult Pass	Unlimited Rides; \$28.00

SENIOR PASS

Golden Age Pass 10 Ride Punch Pass; \$3.00

4. The RETAILER upon demand of the COUNTY will remit all monies received by the RETAILER for the sale of said Bus Tickets.
5. The COUNTY will upon request of the RETAILER supply the RETAILER with additional Bus Tickets and RETAILER shall acknowledge in writing the number of Bus Tickets in RETAILER's custody.
6. The COUNTY will furnish the RETAILER with advertising material created by the COUNTY to promote the sale of said Bus Tickets. RETAILER may promote or advertise the availability of said Bus Tickets in such other manner as may from time to time be approved by COUNTY.
7. The parties hereto shall give to each other not less than seven (7) days' notice of election to terminate this Agreement. Upon termination of the Agreement the RETAILER shall remit all monies not previously paid over to the COUNTY for the sale of said Bus Tickets along with any unsold Bus Tickets and all advertising material furnished to the RETAILER by the COUNTY.
