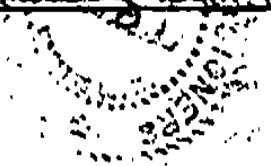
1. The BOARD has the authority to file this grant application.

Trip/Equipment Grant Application

The Recipient hereby assures and certifies that:

- (1) The recipient will comply with the federal, state and local statutes, regulations, executive orders, and administrative requirements which relate to discrimination on the basis of race, color, creed, religion, sex, age, and handicap with respect to employment, service provision, and procurement.
- (2) Public and private for-profit, transit and paratransit operators have been or will be afforded a fair and timely opportunity by the local recipient to participate to the maximum extent feasible in the planning and provision of the proposed transportation planning services.

- (6) Capital equipment purchased through this grant meets or exceeds the criteria set forth in the Florida Department of Transportation's equipment specifications, "Guidelines for Acquiring Vehicles" dated October 1993 (or as updated), and "Part 1, Bid Documents", dated July 1995, (or as updated), and "Part 2, Specification Guidelines for Specialized Vehicles", date July 1993 (or as updated), or criteria set forth by any other federal or state, or local government agency.
- (7) Capital equipment or consultant services purchased through this grant comply with the competitive procurement requirements of Chapter 287 and Chapter 427, Florida Statutes.
- (8) If capital equipment is purchased through this grant, the demand responsive services offered to individuals with disabilities, including individuals that use wheelchairs, is equivalent to the level and quality of services offered to individuals without disabilities. Such service, when viewed in its entirety, is provided in the most integrated setting feasible and is equivalent with respect to:
