RESOLUTION R-97-77

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA DESIGNATING AND SETTING ASIDE FUNDS FROM THE CHILDREN'S SERVICES DEDICATED MILLAGE TO FUND HEALTHY START COALITION OF MANATEE COUNTY, INC.'S TEEN PREGNANCY PREVENTION PROGRAM; SETTING FORTH CERTAIN CONDITIONS AND LIMITATIONS; PROVIDING FOR CONSIDERATION OF ADDITIONAL FUNDING ALLOCATIONS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution R-90-169, the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, did call for a referendum on the question of a dedicated millage for funding children's services; and

WHEREAS, at a special referendum held in Manatee County, Florida, on November 6, 1990, a majority of the voters voted in support of a dedicated millage for children's services; and

WHEREAS, Manatee County Ordinance 91-42, as supplemented and amended, has been adopted for the purpose of enabling and implementing the use of the dedicated millage for funding children's services; and

WHEREAS, the Healthy Start Coalition of Manatee County, Inc. (hereinafter "Healthy Start"), has advised the Board of County Commissioners of the possibility of obtaining grant funds from the Department of Health and Human Services, Region IV, through a collaborative grant program with Emory University Regional Training Center; and

WHEREAS, Healthy Start has applied to the County for children's services funds in the amount of \$100,000.00, which funding is required in addition to anticipated grant funds from the Department of Health and Human Services; and

WHEREAS, data and statistics presented to this Board of County Commissioners indicated a serious need to implement a teen pregnancy prevention program; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 91-42, any of the dedicated millage for children's services not allocated during the adoption of the County's annual budget shall be approved only after notice and a public hearing conducted in the manner required for the adoption of County ordinances; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing to consider funding Healthy Start's Teen Pregnancy Prevention Program has been duly advertised and a public hearing was conducted on April 8, 1997.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

1. The Board hereby acknowledges the serious problem of teen pregnancy in Manatee County and the need to support programs designed to prevent teen pregnancies.
2. The sum of \$100,000.00 is hereby designated and set aside from the children's services dedicated millage to fund Healthy Start's Teen Pregnancy Prevention Program for its first year of operation anticipated to start on July 1, 1997, and continue through June 30, 1998, subject to the limitations and conditions set forth in this Resolution.
3. Disbursement of the funds designated in this Resolution shall only be pursuant to terms and conditions established by written agreement between the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, and Healthy Start, which agreement shall be

conditioned upon an award of grant funds from the Department of Health and Human Services as indicated in the application for funding submitted by Healthy Start to Manatee County Community Services Department on April 2, 1997.

4. It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners to provide, by written agreement, terms and conditions that are complimentary to the requirements applicable to any Department of Health and Human Services grant for the teen pregnancy prevention program. However, the Board of County Commissioners, in its discretion, shall ultimately determine the acceptability of a final agreement pursuant to which County funds will be disbursed to Healthy Start.

5. The Board of County Commissioners acknowledges the value of a continuing program and shall give due consideration to funding applications for the Healthy Start Teen Pregnancy Prevention Program for a three-year period or for so long as the Department of Health and Human Services funding may be made available. The intention of the Board of County Commissioners as expressed herein is limited by the provisions the Florida Constitution and Laws of Florida with regard to pledging ad valorem taxes, and any commitment shall be based solely upon the successful performance of any agreement with Healthy Start in the preceding fiscal year and subject to the Board of County Commissioners' discretion in budgeting and appropriating funds in each County fiscal year.

6. 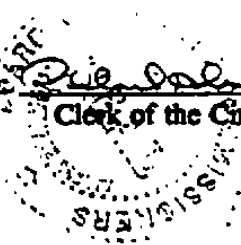

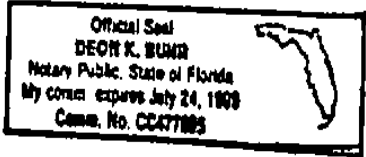

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, will conduct a public hearing in the Chambers of the Board of the Manatee County Administration Center, 112 Manatee Avenue West, first floor, Bradenton, Florida, on the 28th day of April, 1997 at 10:00 a.m., at which time, to consider, discuss, adopt or reject the following funding request:

TO CONSIDER FUNDING FOR THE HEALTHY START COALITION OF MANATEE COUNTY, INC.'S YOUTH PREGNANCY PREVENTION PROGRAM FOR A SUM NOT TO EXCEED \$1000 FOR THE TIME PERIOD ENDING MAY 31, 1997 AND ENDING APRIL 30, 1998.

SECTION 9 OF MANATEE COUNTY ORDINANCE 1-92 AS AMENDED (THE MANATEE COUNTY CHILDREN'S SERVICES ORDINANCE) REQUIRES A PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER ANY ADDITIONAL AWARD OF FUNDING FOR A PROGRAM AFTER ADOPTION OF THE COUNTY'S ANNUAL BUDGET.

According to Section 98.015, Florida Statute, if any person decides to appeal any decision made by the Board with respect to any matter to be considered at the meeting or hearing, he will need a record of the proceedings for such purpose; he may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record would include any testimony or evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
