**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION AND ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS FOR THE ACQUISITION OF AN AUTOMATED FINGERPRINT IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM BY THE MANATEE COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE IN PARTNERSHIP WITH THE SARASOTA COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE**

WHEREAS, Manatee County has determined that the acquisition of an Automated Fingerprint Identification System is in the best interest of the health and welfare of the citizens of Manatee County; and,

WHEREAS, Manatee County has previously entered into an agreement with the Department of Community Affairs for participation in the Federal Anti-Drug Abuse Act Program.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida that

- 1 The submission and acceptance of a grant from the Florida Department of Community Affairs for the Anti-Drug Abuse Act Program is hereby authorized.
- 2 The Chairman, or in her absence, the Vice Chairman, is authorized to execute all appropriate documents with regard to the submission and acceptance of this grant.
3. The Sheriff of Manatee County, Florida is authorized to execute all appropriate documents which may be required in connection with the administrative functions pursuant to the terms of the application and agreement.
