A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA: ACCEPTING A GRANT FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND REHABILITATIVE SERVICES, OFFICE OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES UNDER THE MATCHING GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the State of Florida Department of Health and Rehabilitative Services, Office of Emergency Medical Services provides matching grant funding to assist public organizations improve and expand their EMS systems; and

WHEREAS, the Manatee County Department of Public Safety, Division of Emergency Medical Services is eligible to participate in the matching grant program; and

WHEREAS, the Manatee County Department of Public Safety Division of Emergency Medical Services has identified the need to continue its educational campaign to the citizens of Manatee County to decrease the number of unintentional injuries and increase the community's awareness on injury prevention.

WHEREAS, through the mechanism of utilizing one of the County transit buses, an estimated 500,000 people will be impacted by the delivery of injury prevention related messages.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida that:

The matching grant under the State of Florida Department of Health and Rehabilitative Services, Office of Emergency Medical Services for the "Rolling Public Education Billboard" campaign program is hereby accepted.
