

RESOLUTION R-97-158 RESCINDING RESOLUTION R-97-158 AND ESTABLISHING THE PARKS AND RECREATION POLICY AND FEE SCHEDULE FOR THE MANATEE COUNTY PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 125.01 (1) (f) Florida Statutes authorizes the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida as the legislative and governing body of county government to: (f) Provide parks, preserves, playgrounds, recreation areas and other recreation and cultural facilities and programs; and

WHEREAS, Manatee County's recreational facilities are used for the operation of planned recreation programs, special events, and field trips, organized and supervised by the Parks and Recreation Department; and

WHEREAS, the programs scheduled by the Parks and Recreation Department reflect the recreational needs, interests and desires of the general population; and

WHEREAS, the fees and charges for program offerings, rental and usage of Parks and Recreation facilities are set and determined to make programs and facilities available to the public; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Department generates and accepts donations from individuals, service clubs and the business community for the purpose of offsetting and/or supplementing program administrative costs; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Department enters into co-sponsorships with not-for-profit groups, making available facilities and equipment to benefit Manatee County and its citizens. Any requests for co-sponsorship exceeding a \$ 1,500.00 value will be taken to the Board of County Commissioners for approval; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Department sells t-shirts and uses surplus t-shirts as awards and prizes for various County programs and special events; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS of Manatee County, Florida as follows:

I. DEFINITIONS:

As used in this resolution, the following words shall have the meaning below.

A. "Program" or "Class" or "Planned Activity" - A planned activity organized to meet the needs, interests and desires of the general population.

B. "Resident" - One who has a true, fixed or permanent home in Manatee County, Florida and whenever absent, has the intention of returning to Manatee County. The genuineness of the intention to return to Manatee County must be manifested by an ongoing physical presence together with indications that his/her presence is something other than merely transitory in nature.

- C. "Social" - Any not-for-profit organization utilizing a County facility for the purpose of monetary gain for community support or maintenance of the group or activity itself.
- D. "Commercial" - Any individual, group or organization that requests use of County facilities for the purpose of self-promotion and profit.

II. AGE AND STATUS CATEGORIES:

- A. Senior Citizen - Person 55 Years or Older.
- B. Adult - 18 to 54 Years of Age.
- C. Youth - Children 6 to 17 Years of Age.
- D. Pre-Schooler - Children Under 6 Years of Age.
- E. Family - Family Members Within Same Household; Limit 4 Persons.
- F. Additional - Family Members Within Same Household; Over 4 Person Limit.
- G. Couple - Any 2 Adults Living in Same Household.

III. FEE SCHEDULE:

- A. Fees for Manatee County Parks and Recreation Department equipment and facilities shall be enumerated in Exhibit A, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein.
- B. All fees include tax. However, not-for-profit groups are tax exempt and therefore not assessed tax. This information is noted in the fee schedule.
- C. Program/rental fees are determined by the estimated administrative costs of an activity, which includes, but is not limited to, personnel expenses, utilities, equipment, materials and supplies.
- D. The Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to prorate fees.

IV. RULES AND POLICIES:

A. Requests:

Requests for special use of recreation facilities must be in writing on approved forms and submitted to the Parks and Recreation Department. Applications may be obtained at each facility. Users may apply to reserve facilities on any given date and all reservations must be paid prior to the event. However, payment for picnic shelter reservations must be received within five (5) working days of the request. If payment is not received within this time period the request will be considered cancelled. Reservations may not be accepted after Wednesday for any given

weekend request. However, picnic shelters are available on a first-come, first-serve basis. The Department reserves the right to review all requests for usage of recreation facilities and determine whether or not usage will be granted.

All picnic shelter requests, including family reunions and church functions, regardless of size, shall be considered a resident/social request and assessed the assigned fee. A commercial fee will be assessed only when the group's shelter rental is part of a promotional event.

All not-for-profit youth sports league groups may utilize Department building facilities for the purpose of conducting meetings, registrations and clinics at no charge as long as they are held during regular operating hours and have no negative impact on Department operations.

Staff time will be charged for all functions after regular operating hours.

B. Facility Reservations:

1. Facility Priorities

- a. Programs or activities sponsored by the Parks and Recreation Department will have first priority.
- b. Activities sponsored by the Manatee County School Board or other inter-governmental agencies will have second priority. Manatee County School Board shall have access to equipment and facilities, based on the current Interlocal Agreement. The Manatee County School Board or other inter-governmental agencies shall assume responsibility for repair or replacement of equipment and facilities as a result of damages incurred.
- c. Organizations conducting activities, which are co-sponsored by the Parks and Recreation Department, are considered third priority.
- d. All other requests will be considered on a first-come, first-serve basis at the discretion of the Department Director or designee.

2. Facility Guidelines

- a. Reservations will be subject to cancellation if payment is not made within five (5) working days from the day of the initial request.
- b. Applicants shall abide by all rules and regulations as stated in Park Ordinance 82-19.
- c. Lighted recreation facilities will close at 11:00pm. All other recreation areas will close at dusk unless posted otherwise. Special exceptions will be considered due to the nature of the requested event.

- d. A minimum charge of two (2) hours will be assessed for a requested facility normally closed during the time requested.
- e. Groups requesting facilities for an event special in nature, which would include physical activity, must provide a certificate of insurance with Public liability: \$ 250,000. per person. \$ 500,000. per accident and Property Damage: Minimum \$ 50,000. per accident for any one claim. Manatee County must be named as additional insured.
- f. Groups reserving rooms are allowed up to one (1) hour without charge prior to their activity and are responsible for their own table and chair set up.
- g. Individuals or groups reserving facilities are responsible for cleaning the room(s) after use. This includes cleaning tables and counter tops, mopping spills, depositing trash bags in dumpster and placing tables and chairs in the assigned storage area.
- h. Individuals or groups, requesting the use of facilities, are responsible for providing their own materials and supplies.

- 3. The Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to require additional services at the user's expense.
 - a. The Parks and Recreation Department may require the presence of a building supervisor during the reservation period. An hourly wage will be charged to the user and included on the facility application form.
 - b. The Parks and Recreation Department may require a custodian for activities taking place where cleanup cannot be accomplished during regular operating hours. An hourly wage rate will be charged to the user and included on the facility application form.
 - c. The Parks and Recreation Department may require the presence of off-duty law enforcement officers for security during the activity at the sole expense of the user group or individual.
 - d. In accordance with Resolution R-95-53, the Parks and Recreation Department can enter into concession licenses with not-for-profit organizations provided proper documentation confirms not-for-profit status and the ability to provide insurance. There is a minimum \$ 1.50 utility charge per each day of operation and a minimum \$ 12.50 penalty charge if lights are left on at the specified facility.

- e. Amateur sports leagues may be granted a license to operate concessions during the requested period. Leagues must accept full responsibility and liability and agree to hold harmless and indemnify the County for and against any claims that may arise or judgments that may be entered against the County in connection with their use of County property or facilities.
- f. Youth sports organizations utilizing facilities maintained by the Parks and Recreation Department are required to pay user fees. These include team and player fees which are assessed to help support maintenance needs. (See Exhibit A). Youth organizations will be charged a late fee of 1 1/2% of the total amount due per month for non-payment after the prescribed deadline. A damage fee may be charged to a youth organization if they are found to do damage to a playing field without permission or authorization to be on or working on a given field. All requests for additional maintenance must be received ten (10) days in advance of a scheduled event or a late maintenance fee may be assessed.
- g. A damage deposit may be required for the use of any building facility and/or equipment which may potentially create any physical damage to the requested facility or equipment. In such cases a \$ 100.00 damage deposit must be paid prior to the event or rental of equipment. Reimbursement will be processed if the facility supervisor determines the facility and/or equipment is in the same condition as before the scheduled activity.

V. REFUND/CREDIT POLICY:

Except where provided herein, Manatee County Parks and Recreation activity and facility fees are non-refundable.

A. Refunds:

1. An individual participant presenting a written recommendation from a doctor (two (2) or more absences) indicating that the individual should withdraw from an activity or program, shall be entitled to a full or prorated refund. There would be no administrative fee assessed.
2. An activity or program may be cancelled for the following reasons: insufficient enrollment, instructor hardship, facility under repair, red tide, behavioral problem (expulsion from program) or inclement weather. The individual or group would be entitled to a full or prorated refund or credit. There would be no administrative fee assessed.
3. A refund request may be considered if requested prior to the activity/program. These refunds are subject to a \$ 10.00 administrative fee.
4. All refund requests must be accompanied by an original receipt or a copy of the cancelled check.
5. The Department Director reserves the right to consider refund requests and waive any administrative fees.

B. Credit:

1. The Department may consider the use of credit toward another activity. Credits must be applied for and used toward another activity within ninety (90) days of the program/ activity or forfeiture of credit results. Any application for credit exceeding \$ 100.00 must be approved by the Board of County Commissioners before credit is granted.

VI. RESCISSION OF PRIOR FEE RESOLUTIONS:

- A. Fees for the use of Manatee County Parks and Recreation facilities and participation in recreation activities and programs, heretofore adopted by the Board of County Commissioners, including Resolution R-97-39, are hereby rescinded in their entirety.

VII. IMPLEMENTATION:

- A. This resolution is subject to such supplemental policies, rules and interpretations as may be adopted or provided by the Board of County Commissioners.
- B. The County Administrator or designee is authorized to develop or approve procedures required to implement this resolution.

VIII. EFFECTIVE DATE:

- A. This resolution shall become effective October 1, 1997 excluding after school and recreation class fees, which will become effective upon the execution of this document.

IX. SEVERABILITY:

- A. In the event any provision or portion of this resolution is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be void, unconstitutional or unenforceable, all remaining provisions and portions of this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect. All of the provisions and portions of this Resolution are severable, and the legality and enforceability of any one or more of them are not contingent or dependent upon the validity or unenforceability of any other provision.
