A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF COUNTY FUNDS TO PROVIDE FOR INCENTIVES TO SUPPORT AND AWARDS TO BE PRESENTED TO MEMBERS OF THE DISASTER PREPAREDNESS PLANNING COMMITTEE (DPPC) NETWORK FOR EXCEPTIONAL CONTRIBUTIONS UNDER THE DPPC RECOGNITION PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, has previously adopted Ordinance 97-28 authorizing the expenditure of County funds to provide for incentives and awards; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 97-28 provides that any programs established and expenditures authorized shall be approved by Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida adopted Resolution R-93-139, resolving that the Disaster Preparedness Planning Committee meet on a monthly basis in order to discuss and carry-out disaster preparedness planning; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has considered this Resolution and determined that the expenditure would accomplish the purposes authorized in Ordinance 97-28 and as set forth more fully herein.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, that:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE

A.) It shall be the purpose of this Resolution to (1) recognize and award members of the Disaster Preparedness Planning Committee whose performance exceeds standards for their individual or organization's outstanding achievement for disaster preparedness planning; (2) to promote and recognize effective community-wide emergency management involvement, coordination and contributions and (3) to honor and recognize persons or organizations who contribute to the success of the committee in providing presentations, meeting rooms, hosting luncheons and conducting disaster preparedness training workshops.

B.) The DPPC Recognition Program shall be maintained by the Department of Public Safety, Emergency Management staff, who shall remain duly exempt from committee award nomination and receiving awards for the various categories.

SECTION 2. EXPENDITURES

In order to accomplish the above stated purposes and in keeping with Ordinance #97-28, the following expenditures for incentives and awards are deemed to be valid expenditures of county funds:

- ◆ Frames, plaques, certificates, trophies, pins, paperweights, photographs and other suitable tokens of recognition to acknowledge significant contributions.
- ◆ All or a portion of the cost of non-alcoholic refreshments in connection with training workshops, disaster exercises and coordination meetings in accordance with Resolution R-97-140.

SECTION 3. APPROVAL OF EXPENDITURES

Any expenditures of County funds for the purposes listed above must fall within approved budgetary allotments. The County Administrator is hereby granted the authority to develop and maintain procedures outlining operational aspects to be followed for authorization and approval of expenditures.

This Resolution may be rescinded by the Board of County Commissioners, however, rescinding the Resolution shall in no way prohibit any lawful expenditures made prior to the date this Resolution is rescinded or impair any contract entered into prior to the date this Resolution is rescinded.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
