

RESOLUTION R-02-58

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION, UNDER THE LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND PROGRAM, FOR THE CONTINUED DEVELOPMENT OF BLACKSTONE PARK.

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection provides funding for local government entities to develop land for outdoor recreational purposes under the Land and Water Conservation Fund Program; and

WHEREAS, Blackstone Park is part of the Manatee County Capital Improvement Program slated for continued development as an outdoor recreation park; and

WHEREAS, the Manatee County Board of County Commissioners has determined that the continued development of Blackstone Park will provide the residents of Manatee County with increased recreational opportunities.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, that:

1. The submission of an application to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection for the continued development of Blackstone Park under the Land and Water Conservation Fund program is hereby authorized.
2. The Chairman, or in his or her absence, the Vice Chairman are authorized to execute all appropriate documents with regards to the submission of this application and related documents required pursuant to the application.
