A RESOLUTION OF THE MANATEE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO INCLUDE FIVE (5) NEW POSITIONS INTO THE FLORIDA RETIREMENT SYSTEM'S SENIOR MANAGEMENT SERVICE CLASS.

WHEREAS, the Florida Retirement System (FRS) was established in 1970, by Chapter 121, Florida Statutes, as a compulsory, non-contributory retirement plan for full-time or part-time employees working in regularly established positions in a state agency, county government, district school board, state university, community college or a participating city or special district; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Retirement System has five membership classes, one of which is designated as Senior Management Service Class (SMSC); and

WHEREAS, effective July 1, 2000, the Florida Legislature approved up to 10 additional nonelective full-time positions to be designated as Senior Management Service Class by local governments; and

WHEREAS, each position designated to be included in the Senior Management Service Class must be a nonelective managerial or policy making position; filled by an employee who is not subject to a continuing contract and serves at the pleasure of the employer without civil service protection; and head of an organizational unit or have responsibility to make or recommend personnel, budget, expenditure or policy decisions in his/her areas of responsibility; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, that the following positions be included in the Florida Retirement System's Senior Management Service Class.

Chief Assistant County Administrator
Chief Assistant County Attorney
Deputy Chief Assistant County Attorney for Land Use & Environmental Law
Deputy Assistant County Attorney for Litigation
Deputy Assistant County Attorney for Transactional Law



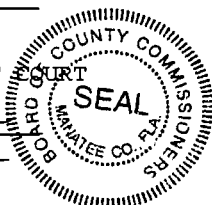
