

RESOLUTION R-03-19

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF AN ELECTRONIC PRODUCTS COLLECTION AND RECYCLING GRANT FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION FOR THE ELECTRONIC PRODUCTS COLLECTION AND RECYCLING PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, The Florida Department of Environmental Protection has made available funding for approved local government entities to initiate and operate electronic products collection and recycling programs; and

WHEREAS, many electronic products contain either lead or mercury, a program for proper disposal via demanufacturing and/or recycling is a constructive approach to abatement of hazardous materials entering the County's Landfill; and

WHEREAS, The Solid Waste Management Facility, 3333 Lena Road, Bradenton, Florida has been approved by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection and is, in part, a designated household hazardous waste collection and disposal site; and

WHEREAS, The Solid Waste Management Facility has entered into contract with private enterprise for the removal and processing of electronic products for demanufacturing and/or recycling processes; and

WHEREAS, The Florida Department of Environmental Protection has made funds available to the County for approved expenditures from July 1, 2002 through December 15, 2003 in the amount of \$50,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County that:

1. The acceptance of a Grant from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection for participation in the Electronic Products Collection and Recycling Grant Program is hereby authorized.
2. The Chairman, or in his absence the Vice Chairman, is authorized to execute all appropriate documents with regard to the acceptance of this Grant.
