**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING THE APPLICATION PROCESS AND SELECTION CRITERIA RELATING TO THE AWARD OF FUNDS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE "DORI SLOSBERG DRIVER EDUCATION ACT", MANATEE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 03-24, FOR DRIVER'S EDUCATION PROGRAMS IN PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS; SETTING APPLICATION DEADLINES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, Section 98, Chapter 2002-20, Laws of Florida (§318.1215, Florida Statutes), known as the "Dori Slosberg Driver Education Safety Act" authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to enact an ordinance requiring the Clerk of the Circuit Court to collect an additional \$3.00 with each civil traffic penalty to be used to fund driver education programs in public and private schools; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners has adopted Ordinance No. 03-24, which authorizes the imposition of the additional \$3.00 penalty to provide driver education programs; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to receive funding from the Driver Education Safety Trust Fund, applicants will be selected as funding recipients based on selection criteria established herein. Grant awards will be made by the Board of County Commissioners on an annual basis from among applicants recommended to it by the County Administrator.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, that:

1. Applicants will be required to complete and submit the funding Application, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A.
2. The date by which such applications shall be submitted to Manatee County will be publicly noticed annually by the County Administrator.
3. The County Administrator or designee will coordinate the review of funding applications, which review will identify applications which meet or exceed the

selection criteria set forth in Exhibit A hereto.

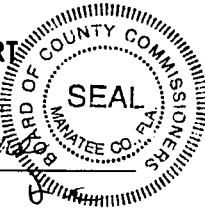

4. The County Administrator will present the results of the review of the funding applications and, as applicable, funding recommendations, to the Board of County Commissioners on a regular Commission Agenda for the Commission's consideration and action.
5. All applicants will be notified within ten (10) days thereafter of funding decisions made by the Board of County Commissioners.


