

## RESOLUTION R-04-48

### **A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF COUNTY FUNDS FOR THE WATER CONSERVATION/RECLAIMED PROGRAM EDUCATION AND PROMOTION PROGRAM; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to §125.01, Florida Statutes, the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County has adopted Ordinance 97-28 which, among other things, authorizes the expenditure of funds to promote, make known and engender goodwill toward the County; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 2.D authorizes the development of programs to promote, make known and engender goodwill, participation and cooperation of individuals, groups and organizations in the activities, services and programs of the County; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 3.F of Ordinance 97-28 authorizes the expenditure of funds for souvenirs and other tokens commemorating and/or promoting programs, events, and undertakings of the County; and

**WHEREAS**, The Manatee County Utility Operations, Water Department, Water Conservation/Reclaimed Program offers numerous educational programs and incentives, including but not limited to indoor and outdoor water conservation programs, school programs and various presentations to civic organizations.

**WHEREAS**, the educational programs provided through the Water Conservation/Reclaimed Program are designed to promote the health, safety and welfare of the citizens and the environment in Manatee County.


### **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT:**

1. Souvenirs and other tokens commemorating and promoting the educational programs of the Utility Operations Department, Water Conservation/Reclaimed Program, will promote both the educational programs and public participation in the Water Conservation rebates. These programs are designed to further the purpose of the Manatee County Water Conservation Program.
2. The expenditure of funds for the purchase of souvenirs and other tokens commemorating and promoting the education programs such as rain gauges, outdoor kits and hose timers, shower timers, student water conservation kits and miscellaneous educational material.


3. All expenditures shall come from monies designated and approved for accomplishing the purposes of this Resolution at the time of adoption of the County Budget.
4. All funds spent under this resolution shall comply with all county procurement requirements.
5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
