

RESOLUTION R-04-68

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA ESTABLISHING A REVISED FEE SCHEDULE FOR WATER WELL CONSTRUCTION PERMITTING IN MANATEE COUNTY; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 373.309 of the Florida Statutes authorizes the collection of fees by governmental entities that have received delegation from the Water Management District to administer the Water Well Construction and Permitting Program within the local jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, Manatee County received such delegation from the Southwest Florida Water Management District and has regulated water well construction in accordance with an Agreement between the Southwest Florida Water Management District and the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, (hereinafter "Board") since April 5, 1978, which Agreement has been reviewed annually; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish a revised Fee Schedule to collect fees that reflect the County's actual costs incurred in administering the water well construction permitting program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. SCHEDULE OF FEES

* "All others" includes, but is not limited to: irrigation wells; industrial wells; livestock wells; well repair and modification; test holes; exploratory/monitoring wells; A/C - return and discharge wells; recovery wells; and sealed water wells.

Section 2. The fees set forth in the above Schedule of Fees are based upon the County's actual costs incurred in administering the water well construction permitting program. Upon collection, such fees shall be used to offset such costs.


Section 3. If any part, section, subsection or other portion of this Resolution, or any application thereof to any person or circumstance is declared to be void, unconstitutional, or invalid for any reason, such part, section, subsection or other portion shall be severable, and the remaining portions of this Resolution and all applications

thereof not having been declared void, unconstitutional or invalid, shall remain in full force and effect.


