

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING R-04-85 TO PROVIDE FOR REVISIONS TO MEMBERSHIP CRITERIA OF THE SENIOR ADVISORY BOARD AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Manatee County has previously established the Senior Advisory Board as provided in R-04-85; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has determined that it is necessary and in the best interest of the Senior Advisory Board to remove the prohibition of employment by or membership on the board of a social service organization which provides services to seniors and to lower the minimum age requirement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, that:

Section 1. Section 4 of Resolution 04-85 is amended to read as follows:

The Advisory Board will be made up of nine (9) members. Each single district commissioner shall appoint a member from their district and each at large commissioner shall appoint a member from the community at large, and two members shall be appointed by the County Administrator and/or his designee. Membership shall be limited in the following manner: each member shall be a citizen of at least 50 years of age; and each member shall reside in Manatee County.

The County Administrator's Office in partnership with the Community Services Department is hereby assigned the responsibility of providing administrative support to the Advisory Board. The Intergovernmental Coordinator shall serve as the liaison with the County Administrator's Office and the County Attorney's Office in accordance with such policies as may be established by the County Administrator and County Attorney.

Section 2. Effective Date.

This Resolution shall be effective as of the date of adoption.
