OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, RESOLUTION COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR OR HIS THE AUTHORIZING INDIVIDUAL DESIGNEES, TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTS OF A **OBTAINING** NATURE ASSOCIATED WITH MINISTERIAL **PERMITS** AND FEDERAL STATE. LOCAL, CONTEMPLATED **AGREEMENTS** FOR CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS WITHIN COUNTY OWNED PROPERTY, PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY, AND PUBLIC EASEMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners pursues many projects within public lands, requiring local, state and federal permits and construction agreements; and

WHEREAS, such permits and instruments require execution by the Board of County Commissioners as owner of the facility; and

WHEREAS, significant costs and time are involved in the preparation of such matters for placement upon Board agenda, which may impede timely submittal, and cause the County to miss opportunities for the economic benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, the delegation in this resolution applies only to documents associated with obtaining local, state, or federal permits or construction agreements for projects within County owned land, public rights of way and public easements.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, that:

1. The Board of County Commissioners hereby authorizes the County Administrator or any of his individual designees such as the Director of Public Works and Director of Utilities to execute the ministerial documents associated with obtaining local, state, and federal permits or construction agreements for contemplated projects within county owned land, public rights-of-way, and public easements. All other

agreements involving initial project approval or significant changes to existing projects will still require Board approval.

2. This resolution repeals Resolution R-96-159.
