A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION AND ACCEPTANCE OF AN EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT (FDLE); AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN, THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR OR THE DEPUTY COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS RELATED TO GRANT SUBMISSION AND ACCEPTANCE; AND AUTHORIZING THE COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT DIRECTOR OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS REQUIRED IN CONNECTION WITH GRANT ADMINISTRATIVE FUNCTIONS.

WHEREAS, Manatee County has determined that submission and acceptance of an Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant from the Florida Department of Law Enforcement is in the best interest of the health and welfare of the citizens of Manatee County.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, that:

1. The submission and acceptance of an Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant from the Florida Department of Law Enforcement in the amount of \$134,301 is hereby authorized.
2. The Chairman, or in her absence, the Vice Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners, or the County Administrator or the Deputy County Administrator are authorized to execute all necessary documents with regards to submission and acceptance of this grant.
3. The Community Services Department Director or her designee, is authorized to execute all appropriate documents which may be required in connection with the administrative functions of the Justice Assistance Grant.

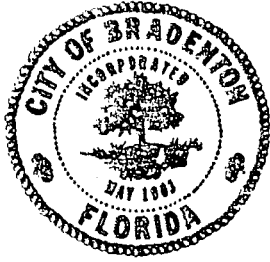
