

RESOLUTION NO. R-13-090

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING RESOLUTION R-12-154
FEE SCHEDULE FOR THE NATURAL RESOURCES DEPARTMENT.**

WHEREAS, Section 125.02(f), Florida Statutes, authorizes the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, as the legislative and governing body of county government, to provide parks, preserves, playgrounds, recreation areas, and other recreation and cultural facilities and programs; and

WHEREAS, Manatee County's Duette Preserve, Headwaters at Duette Preserve, Rye Preserve, Emerson Point Preserve, Robinson Preserve, Riverview Pointe Preserve, and Jiggs Landing (hereinafter "Natural Resources Preserves") are open to the public and used for the operation of planned special events organized and supervised by the Natural Resources Department; and

WHEREAS, the programs scheduled by the Natural Resources Department reflect the recreational opportunities, interests and desires of the general population; and

WHEREAS, the fees and charges for use of the Natural Resources Department's facilities for program offerings, rental and usage of the Natural Resources Preserves, are determined based upon a portion of the cost to the County and set at a rate designed to make the programs and facilities available to the public.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Fees: The fees and charges in Resolution R-12-154 are hereby amended and the new Fee Schedule, attached hereto, is hereby adopted and shall be implemented in accordance with the policies and definitions provided in R-03-167.
2. This resolution and the new fees shall take effect as of June 1, 2013.
