

RESOLUTION NO. R-14-173

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING RESOLUTION R-10-121 OF THE PARKS AND NATURAL RESOURCES FEE SCHEDULE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, §125.01(1)(f), Florida Statutes, authorizes the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, as the legislative and governing body of Manatee County, to provide parks, preserves, playgrounds, recreation areas, and other recreation and cultural facilities and programs; and

WHEREAS, parks and natural resources services are funded in part by user fees generated to cover all or a portion of the costs of such services so as to minimize the burden on the County's general revenue; and

WHEREAS, Manatee County's parks and preserves are open to the public and used for the operation of planned special events organized and supervised by the Parks & Natural Resources Department; and

WHEREAS, Manatee County Code § 2-24-12 provides that the Board of County Commissioners may, upon recommendation of the parks director, adopt, modify or rescind fees or fee ranges for access to various facilities or services offered by the County; and

WHEREAS, the County Commission has previously adopted various fees which have been made a part of the Parks & Recreation and Natural Resources Master Fee Schedules; and

WHEREAS, the new fees now recommended for adoption are based upon the addition of new programming or services, and/or changes to existing programming, services, membership marketing, and/or facilities costs, as well as anticipated revenue from other sources.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT:

1. Separate Exhibit D – D-1 and Attachment (Not-for-Profit Organization Concession License) and Exhibit E and E-1 (License Agreement – Temporary Facility) from the Fee Schedule, to be a stand-alone agreement.
2. The manual of policies, fee schedules, and implementing documents attached hereto as incorporated herein are hereby adopted.
3. Except as otherwise provided herein, this Resolution shall take effect January 1, 2015 and Resolution numbers R-10-121, 10-178, 11,020, 11-116, 11-243, 13-090 and 14-050 are hereby rescinded each in their entirety.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the provisions of this Resolution are severable such that the invalidity of any one provision shall not operate to invalidate any other provision.
