

RESOLUTION NO. R-16-029

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONER OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING RESOLUTION R-15-171 OF THE PARKS AND NATURAL RESOURCES FEE SCHEDULE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, §125.01(1)(f), Florida Statutes, authorizes the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, as the legislative and governing body of Manatee County, to provide parks, preserves, playgrounds, recreation areas, and other recreation and cultural facilities and programs; and

WHEREAS, parks and natural resources services are funded in part by user fees generated to cover all or a portion of the costs of such services so as to minimize the burden on the County's general revenue;

WHEREAS, Manatee County's parks and preserves are open to the public and used for the operation of planner special events organized and supervised by the Parks & Natural Resources Department; and

WHEREAS, Manatee County Code §2-24-12 provides that the Board of County Commissioners may, upon recommendation of the parks director, adopt, modify or rescind fees or fee ranges for access to various facilities or services offered by the County; and

WHEREAS, the County Commission has previously adopted various fees which have been made a part of the Parks and Natural Resources Master Fee Schedule, and

WHEREAS, the new changes now recommended for adoption are based upon changes to recreation membership and swim lesson fees and the rain check policy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT:

1. The fees in Resolution R-15-171 are hereby amended, providing for changes to the following user fees:
 - John H. Marble Pool Rental Fees
 - Personal Trainer Fees
 - Swim Lessons and Water Safety Instructor Fees
 - Youth Camp Fees
 - Jiggs Landing Cabin Rental Fees
 - Emerson Point Preserve Classroom Rental Fees
 - Robinson Preserve Paddle-up Camping Fees
2. This resolution and the fee changes shall take effect as of February 10, 2016.

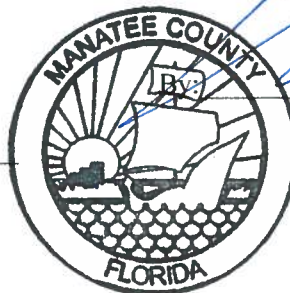
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the provisions of this resolution are severable such that the invalidity of any one provision shall not operate to invalidate any other provision.
