A RESOLUTION MODIFYING THE ASSESSMENT ROLL FOR THE SUNNY SHORES STREET LIGHTING MUNICIPAL SERVICE BENEFIT UNIT (MSBU)

WHEREAS, a street lighting project was approved for installation, operation and maintenance under the provision of Chapter 125.01(Q), Chapter 125.01(R) and Chapter 197.3632, Florida Statutes and **Ordinance 01-39**, which confirmed the adoption of a special street lighting assessment roll and established special assessments on real property designated as **Sunny Shores**; and

WHEREAS, the Ordinance with reference to the above described project was properly filed with the Office of Secretary of State in Tallahassee, Florida and the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida and said Board of County Commissioners did, pursuant to duly published notice, hold a public hearing on **August 21, 2001** to consider the appropriateness of said street lighting project and to consider objections to the confirmation of said roll; and

WHEREAS, since the Sunny Shores Street Lighting MSBU has been established, the Board of County Commissioners has made the following amendments to the assessment roll:
