

## **RESOLUTION NO. R-19-054**

### **A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONER OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING RESOLUTION R-19-032 OF THE PARKS AND NATURAL RESOURCES FEE SCHEDULE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATES.**

**WHEREAS**, §125.01(1)(f), Florida Statutes, authorizes the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, as the legislative and governing body of Manatee County, to provide parks, preserves, playgrounds, recreation areas, and other recreation and cultural facilities and programs; and

**WHEREAS**, parks and natural resources services are funded in part by user fees generated to cover all or a portion of the costs of such services so as to minimize the burden on the County's general revenue;

**WHEREAS**, Manatee County's parks and preserves are open to the public and used for the operation of planned special events organized and supervised by the Parks & Natural Resources Department; and

**WHEREAS**, Manatee County Code §2-24-12 provides that the Board of County Commissioners may, upon recommendation of the Parks and Natural Resources Department Director, adopt, modify or rescind fees or fee ranges for access to various facilities or services offered by the County; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Commission has previously adopted various fees which have been made a part of the Parks and Natural Resources Master Fee Schedule, and

**WHEREAS**, the changes now recommended for adoption are based upon clarification of Personal Training fees, and adding and increasing various fees throughout the Master Fee Schedule.

### **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT:**

1. The changes in Resolution R-19-032 are hereby amended, providing for the following changes to the Master Fee Schedule:
  - a. Add description to Jiggs Landing Boat Ramp Access. (p.31)
  - b. Separate Jiggs Landing Pavilion Rental from Preserve Pavilion Reservations and add description. (p.31)
  - c. Rewrite Jiggs Landing Cabin Rentals description. (p.32)
  - d. Increase Jiggs Landing Cabin Rentals single night(s) fee for Manatee County Residents. (p.32)
  - e. Add Jiggs Landing Cabin Rentals single night(s) fee for non-Manatee County Residents. (p.32)
  - f. Increase Jiggs Landing Cabin Rentals weekly fee for Manatee County Residents. (p.32)
  - g. Add Jiggs Landing Cabin Rentals weekly fee for non-Manatee County Residents (p.32)
  - h. Add Jiggs Landing Cabin Rentals Linens & Towels fee per stay, an optional one-time additional fee. (p.32)
  - i. Add Jiggs Landing Cabin Rentals Pet fee per day. (p.32)
  - j. Add that Jiggs Landing Cabin Rental prices do not include tax and online reservation service fee and that Manatee County residents must show valid identification. (p.32)
  - k. Add Jiggs Landing Cabin Rental fee for Lost/Damaged Gate Access Card. (p.32)
  - l. Add Jiggs Landing Watercraft Rentals category with description and fees. (p.32)
    1. Kayak, single and tandem, 4-hours and full-day rental fee.
    2. Canoe, 4-hours and full-day rental fee.

3. Paddle Board, 4-hours and full-day rental fee.
  4. Canoe or John Boat, w/electric motor, hourly rental fee.
  5. Peddle Boat hourly rental fee.
  6. Pontoon Boat hourly rental fee.
  7. Life Vest, 4-hours rental fee (*not in conjunction with watercraft rentals*).
  8. Paddles, 4-hours rental fee (*not in conjunction with watercraft rentals*).
- m. Add Jiggs Landing Guided River Tours category and fees. (p.32)
1. Eco Tour (1.5-hours), per person and per child (under 10 yrs. old) fees.
  2. Reservoir Tour (50-minutes), per person and per child (under 10 yrs. old) fees.
  3. Linger Lodge/River Tour (3-hours), per person and per child (under 10 yrs. old) fees.
  4. Youth/School/County Organization Group (under 30-minutes) per person fee range.
  5. Private Tour (Boat Rental w/Captain) hourly, plus per person fee.
- n. Add that Discounts offered on a case-by-case basis for Jiggs Landing Guided River Tours fees. (p.32)
- o. Clarify that the 5% Tourist Development Tax is added to primitive and paddle-up camping rentals. (p.34)
2. Fee changes shall take effect as of May 7, 2019.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the provisions of this resolution are severable such that the invalidity of any one provision shall not operate to invalidate any other provision.
