

RESOLUTION NO. R-19-068

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONER OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING RESOLUTION R-19-054 OF THE PARKS AND NATURAL RESOURCES FEE SCHEDULE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATES.

WHEREAS, §125.01(1)(f), Florida Statutes, authorizes the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, as the legislative and governing body of Manatee County, to provide parks, preserves, playgrounds, recreation areas, and other recreation and cultural facilities and programs; and

WHEREAS, parks and natural resources services are funded in part by user fees generated to cover all or a portion of the costs of such services so as to minimize the burden on the County's general revenue;

WHEREAS, Manatee County's parks and preserves are open to the public and used for the operation of planned special events organized and supervised by the Parks & Natural Resources Department; and

WHEREAS, Manatee County Code §2-24-12 provides that the Board of County Commissioners may, upon recommendation of the Parks and Natural Resources Department Director, adopt, modify or rescind fees or fee ranges for access to various facilities or services offered by the County; and

WHEREAS, the County Commission has previously adopted various fees which have been made a part of the Parks and Natural Resources Master Fee Schedule, and

WHEREAS, the changes now recommended for adoption are based upon clarification of class titles, and adding and increasing various fees throughout the Master Fee Schedule.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT:

1. The changes in Resolution R-19-068 are hereby amended, providing for the following changes to the Master Fee Schedule:
 - a. Increase the amount of time patrons can receive their "credit" from one program/activity and use towards another activity from ninety (90) days to within one (1) year from the original request. (p.5)
 - b. Adjust the Director's discretionary authority to write-off credits not used, from within ninety (90) days to within one (1) year. (p.5)
 - c. Renaming the "Swim Lessons" title to "Youth Swim Lessons" and the Adult Swim Lessons" title to "Teen/Adult Swim Lessons". (p.24)
 - d. Remove "Saturday Swim Lessons". (p.24)
 - e. Add "or (6) 30-minute lessons" to Teen/Adult Swim Lessons. (p.24)
 - f. Add a 4-hour Pre-Swim Team Clinic for ages 10-15 for \$25. (p.24)
 - g. Change the name of "Conditioning Clinic" to "Competitive Swim Clinic". (p.24)
 - h. Remove the CPR/First Aid Classes. (p.24)
 - i. Add AED to the CPR-Professional Rescuer class title. (p.24)
 - j. Increase the CPR/AED Re-certification Fee from \$25 to \$35. (p.24)
2. Fee changes shall take effect as of June 18, 2019.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the provisions of this resolution are severable such that the invalidity of any one provision shall not operate to invalidate any other provision.
