**A RESOLUTION OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA,  
AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD TO ENTER  
INTO AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE FEDERAL  
EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY AND THE STATE OF  
FLORIDA, DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT TO  
RECEIVE PUBLIC ASSISTANCE FOR ELIGIBLE DISASTER  
RELIEF ACTIVITIES RESULTING FROM HURRICANE IRMA.**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the provisions of section 401, Public Law 93-288, as amended by P.L. 113-2, 127 Stat. 4 (2013) and codified in 44 CFR, Part 206, Subpart H, summarized in Attachment E to the funding agreement, for FEMA Public Assistance Program, the President of the United States declared Manatee County eligible for emergency public assistance due to Hurricane Irma beginning September 10, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), as a result of the Presidential Declaration FEMA 4337-DR-FL, has made available federal funds for eligible disaster relief activities; and

**WHEREAS**, the FEMA-State Agreement governing the use of those funds requires the State to share in the total costs eligible for federal assistance; and

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 97-152, Laws of Florida, in specific appropriation 1114A, provides that Federal disaster assistance matching requirements shall be equally shared between the State and its subgrantees; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, that:

1. **Fifth Revised Attachment A** - Modification of FEMA-State Agreement No. 4337DRFLP0000001/Z0770 is modified as set forth to increase the Federal funding by \$140,115.59 and the State share by \$20,926.36 for a maximum amount payable under the Agreement to \$13,713,301.65.
2. The Chairman, or in his absence the Vice Chairman, is authorized to execute all appropriate documents with regards to the acceptance of this contract.
3. The Director of Financial Management is authorized to sign the agreement for Manatee County.

**MODIFICATION # Z0770-5 TO SUBGRANT AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN THE DIVISION OF EMERGENCY  
MANAGEMENT AND  
Manatee County Government**

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This Modification is made and entered into by and between the State of Florida, Division of Emergency Management ("the Division"), and Manatee County Government ("Sub-Recipient"), to modify Contract Number Z0770, which began on 9/04/2017 ("the Agreement").

WHEREAS, the Division and the Sub-Recipient have entered into the Agreement, pursuant to which the Division has provided a Subgrant to Sub-Recipient under the public assistance program of \$13,552,259.70 in funds; and,

WHEREAS, the Division and Sub-Recipient desire to modify the Agreement by increasing the Federal funding \$140,115.59 under the Agreement.

WHEREAS, the Division and the Sub-Recipient desire to modify the Scope of Work.

WHEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises of the parties contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. The Agreement is hereby amended to increase the Federal funding by \$140,115.59 and the State share by \$20,926.36 for the maximum amount payable under the Agreement to \$13,713,301.65.
2. The Scope of Work, Attachment A to the Agreement, is hereby modified as set forth in the 5th Revised Attachment A to this Modification, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
3. All provisions of the Agreement being modified and any attachments thereto in conflict with this Modification shall be and are hereby changed to conform with this Modification, effective as of the date of the last execution of this Modification by both parties.
4. All provisions not in conflict with this Modification remain in full force and effect, and are to be performed at the level specified in the Agreement.


