

**RESOLUTION R-21-048**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MANATEE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS REGARDING COUNTY ADMINISTRATION; AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. R-21-031 TO EXTEND THE TERM OF THE ACTING COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Sections 125.73 and 125.74, Florida Statutes (the "Act"), and Article II of Chapter 2-2 of the Manatee County Code of Laws (the "Code"), the current County Administrator, Cheri Coryea, has served as County Administrator of the County since June 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, Pursuant to Resolution No. R-21-031 (the "Appointment Resolution") the Board has appointed Karen Stewart to the position of Acting County Administrator, with an expiration date of March 23, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 125.73(4) of the Act and Section 2-2-22(b) of the Code, the Board wishes to amend the Appointment Resolution to extend the term of Karen Stewart to serve as Acting County Administrator as provided in this Resolution.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MANATEE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1. FINDINGS.** The findings contained in the recitals above are true and correct.

**SECTION 2. AMENDMENT OF APPOINTMENT RESOLUTION.** Section 2.A. of the Appointment Resolution is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

- A. Duration: The appointment of Karen Stewart shall commence on the effective date of this Resolution (February 23, 2021) and shall expire on the earlier of (i) close of business on April 20, 2021, or (ii) the effective date of the appointment of a permanent County Administrator or a replacement Acting County Administrator by resolution of the Board.

All other provisions of the Appointment Resolution shall remain in full force and effect as stated therein.

**SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY.** If any section, sentence, clause or other provision of this Resolution shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not be construed as to render invalid or unconstitutional the remaining sections, sentences, clauses or provisions of this Resolution.


**SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption.
