

RESOLUTION R-21-181

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT TO FEMA UNDER THE FLOOD MITIGATION ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Administration (FEMA) provides funding to eligible local governments to reduce or eliminate the risk of repetitive flood damage to buildings and structures insurable under the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP); and

WHEREAS, FEMA regulations dictate that Manatee County must be the official applicant for the Flood Mitigation Assistance Grant Program on behalf of the property owners; and

WHEREAS, Manatee County was approached by Lynda Williams of 2902 Riverview Blvd, Bradenton, FL 34205, for assistance under this program and the County desires to assist this owner in mitigating their property against future losses; and

WHEREAS, the property owner has submitted all the necessary documentation to Manatee County for the application to be submitted on the deadline date of November 12, 2021.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, that:


1. The County Administrator, or his designee, is authorized to execute all appropriate documents with regards to the submission of this application and related documents required pursuant to the submission.
