ARTICLE XXXVI CONSERVATION AREA
Resolution recommending that amendment be adopted,
to-wit; All Submerged lands in the unincorporated
area of Manatee County, except submerged lands lying
shoreward of a established bulkhead line, are hereby designated as conservation area zone. Submerged
lands in the Conservation Area Zone, including the
waters over such submerged lands, shall be left in
their natural state in order to permit their continued public use and enjoyment.
Dredging or disturbing Conservation Area submerged
lands in any manner is prohibited except in the
following instances:

- 1. Creation of navigation channels.
- 2. Maintenance of navigation channels. Permits to create or maintain navigation channels in the Conservation Area Zone must be secured from the Governing Body and such other agencies that may have jurisdiction prior to work being done.
