MANATEE COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE Z-02-06 - TIPTON REZONE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF MANATEE, FLORIDA, AMENDINGS FOR THE OFFICIAL ZONING ATLAS OF MANATEE COUNTY, ORDINANCE OF THE OFFICIAL ZONING ATLAS OF MANATEE COUNTY LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE OF THE RELATING TO ZONING WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF COUNTY; PROVIDING FOR THE REZONING OF CERTAINS TO A-1 (SUBURBANCE) AGRICULTURE); AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Section 1. <u>FINDINGS OF FACT</u>. The Board of County Commissioners of said County, after considering the testimony, evidence, documentation, application for amendment of the Official Zoning Atlas, the recommendation and findings of the Planning Commission of said County, as well as all other matters presented to said Board at the public hearing hereinafter referenced, hereby makes the following findings of fact:

- A. The Board of County Commissioners has received and considered the report of the Manatee County Planning Commission concerning the application for Official Zoning Atlas Amendment as it relates to the real property described in Section 3 of this Ordinance from A (General Agriculture) to A-1 (Suburban Agriculture).
- B. The Board of County Commissioners held a public hearing on January 28, 2003 regarding said proposed Official Zoning Atlas Amendment described herein in accordance with the requirements of Manatee County Ordinance No. 90-01, the Manatee County Land Development Code, and has further considered the information received at said public hearing.
- C. The proposed amendment to the Official Zoning Atlas regarding the property described in Section 3 herein is found to be consistent with the requirements of Manatee County Ordinance No. 89-01, the Manatee County Comprehensive Plan.

Section 2. <u>AMENDMENT OF THE OFFICIAL ZONING ATLAS</u>. The Official Zoning Atlas of Manatee County, Ordinance No. 90-01, the Manatee County Land Development Code, is hereby amended by changing the zoning from A (General Agriculture) to A-1 (Suburban Agriculture), and the Clerk of the Circuit Court, as Clerk to the Board of County Commissioners, as well as the Planning Department, are hereby instructed to cause such amendment to the said Official Zoning Atlas.

Section 3. LEGAL DESCRIPTION.

THE WEST ½ OF THE EAST ½ OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 11, TOWNSHIP 34 SOUTH, RANGE 18 EAST, MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA. LESS THE NORTH 613 FEET AND LESS THE WEST 20 FEET AND LESS ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY. CONTAINING 5.05 ACRES, MORE OR LESS.

Section 4. <u>EFFECTIVE DATE</u>. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Office of the Secretary of State, Florida Department of State.
