MANAGE CO PANIORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE OFFICIAL ZONING ATLAS OF MANATEE COUNTY, ORDINANCE NO. 90-01 (THE MANATEE COUNTY LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE), RELATING TS ZONING WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF MANATE COUNTY; PROVIDING FOR THE REZONING OF APPROXIMATELY 8.04 ACRES LOCATED AT 11425 CARLTON ROAD FROM THE CON (CONSERVATION) ZONING DISTRICT TO THE A (GENERAL

WHEREAS, Manatee County (the "Applicant") has initiated a rezone application to rezone approximately 8.04 acres described in Exhibit A, attached hereto, (the "Property") from the CON (Conservation) zoning district to the A (General Agriculture, 1 dwelling unit per 5 acres) zoning district; and.

SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Planning Staff has recommended approval of the rezone application as described in the Planning Staff report; and,

WHEREAS, the Manatee County Planning Commission, after due public notice, held a public hearing on June 9, 2005 to consider the rezone application, received the Planning Staff's recommendation and considered the criteria for approval in the Manatee County Comprehensive Plan and the Land Development Code; and,

WHEREAS, the Manatee County Planning Commission, as the County's Local Planning Agency, found the rezone application consistent with the Manatee County Comprehensive Plan and to satisfy the criteria for approval in the Manatee County Land Development Code and recommended approval of the application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

- Section 1. FINDINGS OF FACT. The Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, after considering the testimony, evidence, documentation, application for amendment of the Official Zoning Atlas, the recommendation and findings of the Planning Commission of the County, as well as all other matters presented to the Board at the public hearing hereinafter referenced, hereby makes the following findings of fact:
- The recitals set forth above are true and correct and are hereby adopted as findings by the Α. Board of County Commissioners.
- The Board of County Commissioners has received and considered the report of the Manatee B. County Planning Commission concerning the application for Official Zoning Atlas Amendment as it relates to the real property described in Exhibit A of this Ordinance from CON (Conservation) zoning district to the A (General Agriculture, 1 dwelling unit per 5 acres).

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- C. The Board of County Commissioners held a public hearing on June 14, 2005 regarding the proposed Official Zoning Atlas Amendment described herein in accordance with the requirements of Manatee County Ordinance No. 90-01 (the Manatee County Land Development Code), and has further considered the information received at the public hearing.
- D. The proposed amendment to the Official Zoning Atlas regarding the property described in Exhibit A herein is found to be consistent with the requirements of Manatee County Ordinance No. 89-01 (the 2020 Manatee County Comprehensive Plan).
- Section 2. <u>AMENDMENT OF THE OFFICIAL ZONING ATLAS</u>. The Official Zoning Atlas of Manatee County, Ordinance No. 90-01, the Manatee County Land Development Code, is hereby amended by changing the zoning of the property described in Exhibit A. from the CON (Conservation) zoning district to the A (General Agriculture, 1 dwelling unit per 5 acres) zoning district, and the Clerk of the Circuit Court, as Clerk to the Board of County Commissioners, as well as the Planning Department, are hereby instructed to cause such amendment to the Official Zoning Atlas.
- <u>Section 3. SEVERABILITY</u>. If any section, sentence, clause or other provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not be construed as to render invalid or unconstitutional the remaining sections, sentences, clauses or provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 4. <u>EFFECTIVE DATE</u>. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Office of the Secretary of State, Florida Department of State.

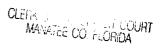
