CLERK OF THE CROUNT A ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE CO. FLORIDA NATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO ZONING WITHIN **AMENDING** UNINCORPORATED AREA; THE OFFICIAL ZONING (ORDINANCE 90-01 THE MANATEE COUNTY LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE) PROVIDING FOR THE REZONING OF APPROXIMATELY 10.35 ACRES COMPRISED OF A 2.3 ACRE PORTION OF A 5 ACRE PARCEL, A 1.63 ACRE PORTION OF A 1.85, ACRE PARCEL, AND A 3.47 ACRE PORTION OF A 3.5 ACRE PARCEL, ALL SEING-> EAST OF RYE ROAD, SOUTH OF RYE WILDERNESS TRAIL, AND ON BOTH SIDES OF THE MANATEE RIVER FROM THE A/NCO (GENERAL AGRICULTURE/NORTH CENTRAL OVERLAY), A-1 (SUBURBAN AGRICULTURE), A-1/CH (SUBURBAN AGRICULTURE/COASTAL HIGH HAZARD). AND A-1/CH/NCO (SUBURBAN AGRICULTURE/COASTAL HIGH HAZARD/NORTH CENTRAL OVERLAY) ZONING DISTRICTS TO CON/CH/NCO ZONING DISTRICT (CONSERVATION, RETAINING THE COASTAL HIGH HAZARD AND NORTH CENTRAL OVERLAY DISTRICTS. AS APPLICABLE); SETTING FORTH FINDINGS; PROVIDING A LEGAL DESCRIPTION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Manatee County (the "Applicant") has filed a rezone application to rezone approximately 7.2 acres as shown on the map n Exhibit "A", attached hereto, (the "Property") from A/NCO (Suburban Agriculture/North Central Overlay), A-1 (Suburban Agriculture), A-1/CH (Suburban Agriculture/Coastal High Hazard), and A-1/CH/NCO (Suburban/Agriculture/Coastal High Hazard/North Central Overlay) zoning district to CON/CH/NCO (Conservation, retaining the Coastal High Hazard and North Central Overlay Districts, as applicable); and

WHEREAS, the Planning staff has recommended approval for the rezone, as described in the Planning staff report; and

WHEREAS, the Manatee County Planning Commission, after due public notice, held a public hearing on April 12, 2007 to consider the rezone, received the Planning staff's recommendation and considered the criteria for approval in the Manatee County Comprehensive Plan and the Land Development Code; and

WHEREAS, the Manatee County Planning Commission, as the County's Local Planning Agency, found the rezone consistent with the Manatee County Comprehensive Plan and to satisfy the criteria for approval in the Manatee County Land Development Code and recommended approval of the applications.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. FINDINGS OF FACT. The recitals set forth above are true and correct and are hereby adopted as findings by the Board of County Commissioners. The Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, after considering the testimony, evidence, documentation, application for amendment of the Official Zoning Atlas, the recommendation and findings of the Planning Commission of the County, as well as all other matters presented to the Board at the public hearing hereinafter referenced, hereby makes the following findings of fact:

- A. The Board of County Commissioners has received and considered the report of the Manatee County Planning Commission concerning the application for Official Zoning Atlas Amendment as it relates to the real property shown in Exhibit "A" of this Ordinance from the A/NCO (General Agriculture/North Central Overlay), A-1 (Suburban Agriculture), A-1/CH (Suburban Agriculture/Coastal High Hazard/North Central Overlay) zoning district to the CON/CH/NCO zoning district (Conservation, retaining the Coastal High Hazard and North Central Overlay Districts, as applicable).
- B. The Board of County Commissioners held a public hearing on May 3, 2007 regarding the proposed Official Zoning Atlas Amendment described herein in accordance with the requirements of Manatee County Ordinance No. 90-01 (the Manatee County Land Development Code), and has further considered the information received at the public hearing.
- C. The proposed amendment to the Official Zoning Atlas regarding the property described in Exhibit "A" herein is found to be consistent with the requirements of Manatee County Ordinance No. 89-01 (the 2020 Manatee County Comprehensive Plan).
- Section 2. AMENDMENT OF THE OFFICIAL ZONING ATLAS. The Official Zoning Atlas of Manatee County, Ordinance No. 90-01, the Manatee County Land Development Code, is hereby amended by changing the zoning district classification of the property described in Exhibit "A" incorporated by reference herein from the A/NCO (General agriculture/North Central Overlay), A-1 (Suburban Agriculture), A-1/CH (Suburban Agriculture/Coastal High Hazard), and A-1/CH/NCO (Suburban Agriculture/coastal High Hazard/North Central Overlay) zoning districts to the CON/CH/NCO zoning district (Conservation, retaining the Coastal High Hazard and North Central Overlay Districts, as applicable), and the Clerk of the Circuit Court, as Clerk to the Board of County Commissioners, as well as the Planning Department, are hereby instructed to cause such amendment to the Official Zoning Atlas.

<u>Section 3. SEVERABILITY.</u> If any section, sentence, clause or other provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such section, sentence, clause, or provision shall be deemed severable, and such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not be construed as to render invalid or unconstitutional the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, or provisions of this Ordinance.

<u>Section 4. CODIFICATION.</u> Pursuant to § 125.68(1), Florida Statutes, this ordinance is not required to be codified. Therefore, the Clerk shall not transmit the ordinance for codification.


