AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CLERK C. MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, REGARDING LAND DEVELOPMENT, MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, REGARDING LAND DEVELOPMENT, ORDINANCE NO. 90-01 (THE MANATEE COUNTY LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE), RELATING TO ZONING WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA; PROVIDING FOR THE REZONING OF APPROXIMATELY 299 ACRES NORTH OF TAYLOR GRADE ROAD AND EAST OF REVELL ROAD IN SECTIONS 15 AND 16, TOWNSHIP 33S, RANGE 21E FROM A (GENERAL AGRICULTURE, 1 DWELLING UNIT PER 5 ACRES) TO THE EX (EXTRACTION) ZONING DISTRICT; SETTING FORTH FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Mosaic Fertilizer, LLC (the "Applicant") filed an application to rezone approximately 299 acres described in Exhibit "A", attached hereto, (the "Property") from A (General Agriculture, 1 dwelling unit per 5 acres) to the EX (Extraction) zoning district; and

WHEREAS, Planning staff recommended approval of the rezone, as described in the staff report; and

WHEREAS, the Manatee County Planning Commission, after due public notice, held a public hearing on 02/14/08, 3/13/08, and 05/08/08 to consider the rezone, received the staff recommendation and considered the criteria for approval in the Manatee County Comprehensive Plan and the Land Development Code; and

WHEREAS, the Manatee County Planning Commission, as the County's Local Planning Agency, found the rezone consistent with the Manatee County Comprehensive Plan and to satisfy the criteria for approval in the Manatee County Land Development Code and recommended approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1. FINDINGS OF FACT</u>. The recitals set forth above are true and correct and are hereby adopted as findings by the Board of County Commissioners. The Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, after considering the testimony, evidence, documentation, application for amendment of the Official Zoning Atlas, the recommendation and findings of the Planning Commission as well as all other matters presented to the Board at the public hearing hereinafter referenced, hereby makes the following findings of fact:

- A. The Board of County Commissioners has received and considered the report of the Manatee County Planning Commission concerning the application for Official Zoning Atlas Amendment as it relates to the real property described in Exhibit "A" of this Ordinance from A (General Agriculture, 1 dwelling unit per 5 acres) to the EX (Extraction) zoning district.
- B. The Board of County Commissioners held a public hearing on 03/06/08, 04/03/08, 6/03/08, and 08/07/08 regarding the proposed Official Zoning Atlas Amendment described herein in accordance with the requirements of Manatee County Ordinance No. 90-01 (the Manatee County Land Development Code), and has further considered the information received at the public hearing.

- C. The proposed amendment to the Official Zoning Atlas regarding the property described in Section 3 herein is found to be consistent with the requirements of Manatee County Ordinance No. 89-01 (the 2020 Manatee County Comprehensive Plan).
- Section 2. AMENDMENT OF THE OFFICIAL ZONING ATLAS. The Official Zoning Atlas of Manatee County (Ordinance No. 90-01, the Manatee County Land Development Code) is hereby amended by changing the zoning classification of the property described in Exhibit A incorporated by reference herein from A (General Agriculture, 1 dwelling unit per 5 acres) to the EX (Extraction) zoning district, and the Clerk of the Circuit Court, as Clerk to the Board of County Commissioners, as well as the Planning Department, are hereby instructed to cause such amendment to the Official Zoning Atlas.
- <u>Section 3. SEVERABILITY.</u> If any section, sentence, clause, or other provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not be construed as to render invalid or unconstitutional the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, or provisions of this Ordinance.

<u>Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE</u>. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Office of the Secretary of State, Florida Department of State.


