AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, REGARDING LAND DEVELOPMENT, AMENDING THE OFFICIAL ZONING ATLAS (ORDINANCE 15-17, AS AMENDED, THE MANATEE COUNTY LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE), RELATING TO ZONING WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF APPROXIMATELY 7.17 ACRES GENERALLY LOCATED APPROXIMATELY ONE-HALF MILE NORTH OF STATE ROAD 70, BETWEEN US 301 AND 301 BOULEVARD EAST. AND COMMONLY KNOWN AS 4808 18TH STREET EAST BRADENTON (MANATEE COUNTY); PROVIDING FOR A REZONE OF APPROXIMATELY 3.37 ACRES FROM AGRICULTURE SUBURBAN DISTRICT (A-1) TO THE RESIDENTIAL-MULTI-FAMILY DISTRICT - 6 DWELLING UNITS PER ACRE (RMF-6) ZONING DISTRICT AND APPROXIMATELY 3.8 ACRES FROM RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY DISTRICT - 4.5 DWELLING UNITS PER ACRE (RSF-4.5) TO THE RESIDENTIAL-MULTI-FAMILY DISTRICT - 6 DWELLING UNITS PER ACRE (RMF-6) ZONING DISTRICT; SETTING FORTH FINDINGS; PROVIDING A LEGAL DESCRIPTION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Michael Burnett (the "Applicant") filed an application to rezone approximately 7.17 acres described in Exhibit "A", attached hereto, (the "Property") for approximately 3.37 Acres from Agriculture Suburban District (A-1) to the Residential-Multi-Family District — 6 Dwelling Units Per Acre (RMF-6) zoning district and approximately 3.8 acres from Residential Single Family District — 4.5 Dwelling Units Per Acre (RSF-4.5) to the Residential-Multi-Family District — 6 Dwelling Units Per Acre (RMF-6) zoning district; and

WHEREAS, the Building and Development Services staff has recommended approval of the rezone, as described in the staff report; and

WHEREAS, the Manatee County Planning Commission, after due public notice, held a public hearing on September 10, 2020 to consider the rezone, received the staff recommendation and considered the criteria for approval in the Manatee County Comprehensive Plan and the Land Development Code; and

WHEREAS, the Manatee County Planning Commission, as the County's Local Planning Agency, found the rezone consistent with the Manatee County Comprehensive Plan and to satisfy the criteria for approval in the Manatee County Land Development Code and recommended approval of the application.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA;

Section 1. FINDINGS OF FACT. The recitals set forth above are true and correct and are hereby adopted as findings by the Board of County Commissioners. The Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, after considering the testimony, evidence, documentation, application for amendment of the Official Zoning Atlas, the recommendation and findings of the

Planning Commission of the County, as well as all other matters presented to the Board at the public hearing hereinafter referenced, hereby makes the following findings of fact:

- A. The Board of County Commissioners has received and considered the report of the Manatee County Planning Commission concerned the application for Official Zoning Atlas Amendment as it relates to the real property described in Exhibit "A" of this Ordinance for approximately 3.37 acres from Agriculture Suburban District (A-1) to the Residential-Multi-Family District 6 Dwelling Units Per Acre (RMF-6) zoning district and approximately 3.8 acres from Residential Single Family District 4.5 Dwelling Units Per Acre (RMF-6) zoning district.
- B. The Board of County Commissioners, after due public notice, held a public hearing on October 1, 2020 regarding the proposed Official Zoning Atlas Amendment described herein in accordance with the requirements of the Manatee County Land Development Code and has further considered the information received at the public hearing.
- C. The proposed amendment to the Official Zoning Atlas regarding the property described in Exhibit "A" herein is found to be consistent with the requirements of the Manatee County Comprehensive Plan and to satisfy the criteria for approval in the Land Development Code.
- Section 2. AMENDMENT OF THE OFFICIAL ZONING ATLAS. The Official Zoning Atlas of Manatee County, Ordinance No. 15-17, the Manatee County Land Development Code, is hereby amended by changing the zoning district classification of the property described in Exhibit "A", incorporated by reference herein, for approximately 3.37 acres from Agriculture Suburban District (A-1) to the Residential-Multi-Family District 6 Dwelling Units Per Acre (RMF-6) zoning district and approximately 3.8 acres from Residential Single Family District 4.5 Dwelling Units Per Acre (RSF-4.5) to the Residential-Multi-Family District 6 Dwelling Units Per Acre (RMF-6) zoning district, and the Clerk of the Circuit Court, as clerk to the Board of County Commissioners, as well as the Building and Development Services Department, are hereby instructed to cause such amendment to the Official Zoning Atlas.
- **Section 3. SEVERABILITY.** If any section, sentence, clause, or other provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such section, sentence, clause, or provision shall be deemed severable, and such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not be construed as to render invalid or unconstitutional the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, or provisions of this Ordinance.
- **Section 4. CODIFICATION.** Pursuant to § 125.68(1), Florida Statutes, this ordinance is not required to be codified. Therefore, the Clerk shall not transmit the ordinance for codification.
- **Section 5. STATE AND FEDERAL PERMITTING.** The issuance of the local development permit by the County shall not create any liability on the part of the County in the event the applicant fails to obtain the required state or federal agency approval or permits or fails to fulfill the obligations imposed by any state or federal agency or undertakes actions that result in a violation of state or federal law.
- **Section 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Office of the Secretary of State, Florida Department of State.
