AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF MANATEE, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE OFFICIAL ZONING ATLAS OFF
MANATEE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 81-4, THE MANATEE COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE ZONING AND LANDDEVELOPMENT CODE, RELATING TO ZONING WITHING
THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF MANATEE COUNTY;
PROVIDING FOR THE REZONING OF CERTAIN LANDFROM R-2/AF (ONE AND TWO FAMILY RESIDENTIAL)
TO C-1A/AF (RESORT COMMERCIAL) RETAINING THE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. FINDINGS OF FACT The Board of County Commissioners of said County, after considering the testimony, evidence, documentation, application for amendment of the Official Zoning Atlas, the recommendation and findings of the Planning Commission of said County as well as all other matters presented to said Board at the Public Hearing hereinafter referenced, hereby makes the following findings of fact:

- A. The Board of County Commissioners has received and considered the report of the Manatee County Planning Commission concerning the application for Official Zoning Atlas Amendment as it relates to the real property described in Section 3 of this Ordinance from R-2/AF (One and Two Family Residential) to C-1A/AF (Resort Commercial) retaining the Agricultural Fringe Overlay District.
- B. The said Board of County Commissioners held a Public Hearing on March 12, 1987, regarding said proposed Official Zoning Atlas Amendment described herein in accordance with the requirements of Manatee County Ordinance No. 81-4, THE MANATEE COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE ZONING AND LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE and has further considered the information received at said Public Hearing.
- C. The proposed amendment to the Official Zoning Atlas regarding the property described in Section 3 herein is found to be consistent with the requirements of Manatee County Ordinance No. 80-4, THE MANATEE PLAN.
- Section 2. AMENDMENT OF OFFICIAL ZONING ATLAS

 official Zoning Atlas of Manatee County Ordinance No. 81-4, THE

 hereby amended by changing the zoning district classification of
 the property identified in Section 3 herein from R-2/AF (One and
 Two Family Residential) to C-1A/AF (Resort Commercial) retaining
 the Agricultural Fringe Overlay District and the Clerk of the
 Circuit Court, as Clerk to the Board of County Commissioners, as
 well as the Planning and Development Department are hereby instructed to cause such amendment to the said Official Zoning
 Atlas.

Section 3. Legal Description:

Commence at the Northwest corner of the West 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 17, Township 35 S., Range 18 E.; thence S 00°16'00" E, along the West line of said West 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4, 260.00 ft. for a Point of Beginning; thence S 89°40'00" E, 236.73 ft. more or less to the West boundary of "Sandra Acres" as per plat thereof recorded in Plat Book 8, page 114 of the Public Records of Manatee County, Florida; thence S 00°28'30" E, along the West boundary of said "Sandra Acres," a distance of 298.50

ft., more or less, to the Southwest corner of Lot 14 of said "Sandra Acres;" thence N 89°40'00" W, a distance of 242.90 ft. more or less to the West boundary of said West 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4; thence N 00°16'00" E, along the West boundary of said West 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4, a distance of 298.50 ft. to the Point of Beginning, being and lying in Section 17, Township 35 S, Range 18 E, Manatee County, Florida.
