

MANATEE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. Z-86-130

EUGENE AND ARLEEN MUSGRAVE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF MANATEE, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE OFFICIAL ZONING ATLAS OF MANATEE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 81-4, THE MANATEE COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE ZONING AND LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE, RELATING TO ZONING WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF MANATEE COUNTY, PROVIDING FOR THE REZONING OF CERTAIN LAND FROM A-1 (SUBURBAN AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT, 1 DU/ACRE) TO R-5 (RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PARK RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT, 12 SITES/ACRE), RETAINING THE AF (AGRICULTURAL FRINGE OVERLAY DISTRICT) ON THE PRESENT PORTIONS OF THE SITE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. FINDINGS OF FACT The Board of County Commissioners of said County, after considering the testimony, evidence, documentation, application for amendment of the Official Zoning Atlas, the recommendation and findings of the Planning Commission of said County as well as all other matters presented to said Board at the Public Hearing hereinafter referenced, hereby makes the following findings of fact:

A. The Board of County Commissioners has received and considered the report of the Manatee County Planning Commission concerning the application for Official Zoning Atlas Amendment as it relates to the real property described in Section 3 of this Ordinance from A-1 (Suburban Agricultural District, 1 du/acre) to R-5 (Recreational Vehicle Park Residential District, 12 sites/acre), retaining the AF (Agricultural Fringe Overlay District) on the present portions of the site.

B. The said Board of County Commissioners held a Public Hearing on March 26, 1987, regarding said proposed Official Zoning Atlas Amendment described herein in accordance with the requirements of Manatee County Ordinance No. 81-4, THE MANATEE COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE ZONING AND LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE and has further considered the information received at said Public Hearing.

C. The proposed amendment to the Official Zoning Atlas regarding the property described in Section 3 herein is found to be consistent with the requirements of Manatee County Ordinance No. 80-4, THE MANATEE PLAN.

Section 2. AMENDMENT OF OFFICIAL ZONING ATLAS The official Zoning Atlas of Manatee County Ordinance No. 81-4, THE MANATEE COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE ZONING AND LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE is hereby amended by changing the zoning district classification of the property identified in Section 3 herein from A-1 (Suburban Agricultural District, 1 du/acre) to R-5 (Recreational Vehicle Park Residential District, 12 sites/acre), retaining the AF (Agricultural Fringe Overlay District) on the present portions of the site and the Clerk of the Circuit Court, as Clerk to the Board of County Commissioners, as well as the Planning and Development Department are hereby instructed to cause such amendment to the said Official Zoning Atlas.

Section 3. Legal Description:

That part of the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 11, Township 35 South, Range 18 East, Manatee County, Florida, being more particularly described as follows: Commence at the NW corner of the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of said Section 11, thence S 00°44'04" E, along the West line of said NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4, 545.87 feet to the South line of lands of Jeanie M. Remsnyder as described in OR Book 1105, Page 2661, Public Records of Manatee County, Florida, for a Point of Beginning; thence continue S 00°44'04" E, along said West line, 777.37 feet to the SW corner of said NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 11; thence S 89°32'20" E, along the South line of said NE 1/4, 1604.07 feet to the East line of the West 1/2 of said Section 11; thence N 00°44'08" W, along said East line, 810.84 feet to its intersection with the aforementioned South line of Jeanie M. Remsnyder and its Easterly extension thereof; thence S 89°15'56" W, along said South line, 1603.71 feet to the Point of Beginning. Containing 29.236 acres, more or less.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon the receipt of the official acknowledgment from the Office of the Secretary of State, State of Florida, that same has been filed with that office.
