BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

- Section 1. FINDINGS OF FACT The Board of County Commissioners of said County, after considering the testimony, evidence, documentation, application for amendment of the Official Zoning Atlas, the recommendation and findings of the Planning Commission of said County as well as all other matters presented to said Board at the Public Hearing hereinafter referenced, hereby makes the following findings of fact:
- A. The Board of County Commissioners has received and considered the report of the Manatee County Planning Commission concerning the application for Official Zoning Atlas Amendment as it relates to the real property described in Section 3 of this Ordinance from A-1 (Suburban Agricultural District, one du/acre) to R-1A (One Family Residential District, 4.4 du/acre).
- B. The said Board of County Commissioners held a Public Hearing on May 22, 1986, regarding said proposed Official Zoning Atlas Amendment described herein in accordance with the requirements of Manatee County Ordinance No. 81-4, THE MANATEE COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE ZONING AND LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE and has further considered the information received at said Public Hearing.
- C. The proposed amendment to the Official Zoning Atlas regarding the property described in Section 3 herein is found to be consistent with the requirements of Manatee County Ordinance No. 80-4, THE MANATEE PLAN.

  the Planning and Development Department are hereby instructed to
  cause such amendment to the said Official Zoning Atlas.

The west  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the N.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the N.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  and the west 66 ft. of the east  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the N.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the N.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 32, Twp. 35 S., Rge. 18E., Manatee County, Florida, less the north 30 ft. for road R/W.

Section 4. <u>EFFECTIVE DATE</u> This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon the receipt of the official acknowledgment from the Office of the Secretary of State, State of Florida, that same has been filed with that office.


