BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

- Section 1. <u>FINDINGS OF FACT</u> The Board of County Commissioners of said County, after considering the testimony, evidence, documentation, application for amendment of the Official Zoning Atlas, the recommendation and findings of the Planning Commission of said County as well as all other matters presented to said Board at the Public Hearing hereinafter referenced, hereby makes the following findings of fact:
- A. The Board of County Commissioners has received and considered the report of the Manatee County Planning Commission concerning the application for Official Zoning Atlas Amendment as it relates to the real property described in Section 3 of this Ordinance from A-1 (Suburban Agriculture, 1 du/acre) to R-1AB (One Family Residential District, 3 du/acre).
- B. The said Board of County Commissioners held a Public Hearing on October 23, 1986, regarding said proposed Official Zoning Atlas Amendment described herein in accordance with the requirements of Manatee County Ordinance No. 81-4, THE MANATEE COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE ZONING AND LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE and has further considered the information received at said Public Hearing.
- C. The proposed amendment to the Official Zoning Atlas regarding the property described in Section 3 herein is found to be consistent with the requirements of Manatee County Ordinance No. 80-4, THE MANATEE PLAN.
- Section 2. AMENDMENT OF OFFICIAL ZONING ATLAS The official Zoning Atlas of Manatee County, Ordinance No. 81-4, THE MANATEE COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE ZONING AND LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE is hereby amended by changing the zoning district classification of the property identified in Section 3 herein from A-1 (Suburban Agriculture, 1 du/acre) to R-1AB (One Family Residential District, 5.3 du/acre) and the Clerk of the Circuit Court, as Clerk to the Board of County Commissioners, as well as the Planning and Development Department are hereby instructed to cause such amendment to the said Official Zoning Atlas.

Section 3. Legal Description:

The E 105 ft of the W 210 ft of the E 1/2 of NW 1/4 of SE 1/4, less the South 420 ft and reserving a 20 ft strip off the North end for road. Section 7, Township 35 S, Range 18 E, containing 2.17 acres more or less.

Section 4. <u>EFFECTIVE DATE</u> This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon the receipt of the official acknowledgment from the Office of the Secretary of State, State of Florida, that same has been filed with that office.


