AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF MANATEE FLORIDA, AMENDING THE OFFICIAL ZONING ATLAST OF MANATEE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 81-4, THE MANATEE COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE ZONING AND LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE, RELATING TO ZONING WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF MANATEE COUNTY; PROVIDING FOR THE REZONING OF CERTAIN LANDED FROM R-5 (RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PARK DISTRICT) TO C-2 (HEAVY COMMERCIAL DISTRICT); PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. <u>FINDINGS OF FACT</u> The Board of County Commissioners of said County, after considering the testimony, evidence, documentation, application for amendment of the Official Zoning Atlas, the recommendation and findings of the Planning Commission of said County as well as all other matters presented to said Board at the Public Hearing hereinafter referenced, hereby makes the following findings of fact:

- A. The Board of County Commissioners has received and considered the report of the Manatee County Planning Commission concerning the application for Official Zoning Atlas Amendment as it relates to the real property described in Section 3 of this Ordinance from R-5 (Recreational Vehicle Park District) to C-2 (Heavy Commercial District).
- B. The said Board of County Commissioners held a Public Hearing on May 14, 1987, regarding said proposed Official Zoning Atlas Amendment described herein in accordance with the requirements of Manatee County Ordinance No. 81-4, THE MANATEE COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE ZONING AND LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE and has further considered the information received at said Public Hearing.
- C. The proposed amendment to the Official Zoning Atlas regarding the property described in Section 3 herein is found to be consistent with the requirements of Manatee County Ordinance No. 80-4, THE MANATEE PLAN.
- Section 2. AMENDMENT OF OFFICIAL ZONING ATLAS The official Zoning Atlas of Manatee County Ordinance No. 81-4, THE MANATEE COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE ZONING AND LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE is hereby amended by changing the zoning district classification of the property identified in Section 3 herein from R-5 (Recreational Vehicle Park District) to C-2 (Heavy Commercial District) and the Clerk of the Circuit Court, as Clerk to the Board of County Commissioners, as well as the Planning and Development Department are hereby instructed to cause such amendment to the said Official Zoning Atlas.

## Section 3. Legal Description:

A part of that certain parcel of land as described in O.R.B. 989, Page 3402 of the Public Records of Manatee County, Florida, currently zoned as R-5 being described as follows:

Commencing at the N.W. corner of the N.E. 1/4 of Section 18, Township 33 South, Range 18 East, Manatee County, Florida; thence S 00°18'34" E, along the half section line, a distance of 674.00 feet; thence N 89°37'52" E, a distance of 116.36 feet to the east right of way line of U.S. Highway 41; thence S 00°29'47" E, along said right of way line, a
